Delhi.

5. The petitioners seek a direction to the respondents to pay an ex-gratia

amount of Rs.10,000/- to all persons working as domestic helps in the NCT

of Delhi and also ensure that these persons are granted free ration without

requiring the production of their Ration Card, Aadhaar Card or any other ID

card.

6. Issue notice. Learned counsel for the respondent accepts notice. He

prays for and is granted 4 weeks' time to file a counter affidavit. Rejoinder

thereto, if any, be filed within two weeks thereafter.

7. Learned Counsel for the respondent further submits that a notification
